10 for 10 Fundraising Campaign

Goal:

- To raise funds for Canadian Holodomor awareness initiatives in 2008 coordinated by the Ukrainian Canadian Congress
- To establish a permanent Holodomor Education Fund which will support ongoing educational initiatives

Theme: \$10 in memory of 10 million

Donations will be accepted in all Ukrainian credit unions throughout Canada. All donations should be made to the **UCC Holodomor Awareness Fund**. Donations can also be sent directly to the Ukrainian Canadian Congress, Suite 647, 167 Lombard Avenue, Winnipeg, MB R3B 0V3. Cheques should be made payable to UCC Charitable and Educational Trust - Holodomor Awareness Fund.

Members who donate \$10 will receive a commemorative pin; members who donate \$25 or more can also receive a tax receipt. Donors who make a contribution of \$250 or more will be entitled to designate their donation for a specific project.

Timeline: April 1 - June 30, 2008

What will your donation support?

Your donation will support the UCC campaign for raising awareness of the Holodomor in Canada. Some of the initiatives your donation will support include:

- Publication and distribution of educational materials in the English, French and Ukrainian languages about the Holodomor for the general Canadian public and the Ukrainian community
- *Keep the Flame Alive* - Commemorative event marking the arrival in Canada of the International Remembrance Flame
- Development of teaching materials on the Holodomor for teachers in our public, catholic and private schools across the country
- Documentation of the stories of all survivors of the Holodomor currently living in Canada to ensure their stories are included in the International Memorial Book (Knyha Pamyati) initiated by Ukraine's President Viktor Yushchenko
- Promotion of National Holodomor Awareness Week in November, 2008

Funds remaining at the end of the 75th anniversary commemorative year will be transferred to a permanent endowment fund for continued Holodomor research and education.

How can organizations help?

Organizations can assist with the fundraising effort by collecting donations and selling commemorative pins. Donor forms will be available at www.ucc.ca.

Organizations are requested to submit an order for pins to ensure that everyone who donates \$10 receives a pin. Please note that these pins should also be sold (\$10) during upcoming commemorative events. Orders can be submitted by filling out the attached order form and either emailing or faxing it to 416-538-6975. Orders for pins will be filled after April 7.

The NHCC is grateful for the support of UCC member organizations, branches and provincial councils. We are proposing that \$2 from the sale of every pin remain with the organization or community to fund local Holodomor commemorative and awareness initiatives.
