UCC Toronto 80th Anniversary Student Scholarship Award for Community Engagement

To commemorate its 80th Anniversary, the UCC Toronto Branch is launching the UCC Toronto 80th Anniversary Student Scholarship Award.

The objective of the **UCC Toronto 80th Anniversary Student Scholarship Award** for Community Engagement and Emerging Leadership is to recognize significant youth volunteer engagement by providing one or more scholarships to Ukrainian Canadian students who are currently enrolled at an accredited university, college or post-secondary program of studies in the Greater Toronto Area. This year, up to 8 scholarships of \$1,000 will be awarded to eligible students.

We gratefully acknowledge that this student award is made possible by funds donated from the estate of Mr. Roman Kolesnik, a long-time supporter of the UCC Toronto Branch.

Basic eligibility requirements (please read carefully):

- Must be between ages 18 and 29
- Must have completed at least one year of a recognized and accredited post-secondary program in the Greater Toronto Area
- Must reside in the GTA or attend school in the GTA
- Must be a Canadian citizen or lawful resident of Canada

If you are eligible, please continue to the application process. You **MUST** submit a complete application package consisting of the following (incomplete application packages will not be considered):

1. Official transcript showing completion of one year of studies
2. Completed application form – see below
3. Two Referee Evaluations (form provided) from recognized GTA Ukrainian Canadian Organizations
4. Recent resume/CV
5. Checklist (provided) indicating all sections are completed and attached
